DOC Douro

GRAPE VARIETIES:

Touriga Nacional, Tinta Roriz, Touriga Barroca, Touriga Franca

ALCOHOL:

13%

WINEMAKER:

Maria Antónia Gomes

HARVEST:

100% Manual

VINIFICATION:

The grapes are crushed and completely pulled out from the stalks. Fermentation with strong maceration and controlled temperature.

TASTING NOTES:

Dark red fruits on the nose. Dry, balanced tannins on the palate. Quick finish leaves room for another sip.

SUGGESTIONS:

Serve at a temperature of 16°C (60.8°F) to 18°C (64.4°F) with red meats and soft cheeses.
